1. Apologies for absence – Linda Cooke, Cathy and Phil Brown.
2. Minutes of the meeting of 31st March 2015 were accepted.
3. FEEDBACK FROM ACTIONS :

Annual Parish Meeting

Comments were made about not having a Neighbourhood Plan, and therefore a request was made by the Chairman of the Parish Council for details of anyone interested in being involved. Annette took the names and has forwarded them on to the Clerk. Annette gave a resume of the works done by the Village Plan Group and responded very well to the negative comments from the public. A member of the Village Plan group was not happy with the progress of the group and commented in a negative manner about the project. As this member has also failed to attend any recent meetings it was therefore decided to send a letter to the member to see if she wishes to resign.

4. Photocopying of the Questionnaire

It was decided that 5 x A4 sheets would be required , folded and stapled into a booklet. There will need to be a 'front cover' with the logo and some information and possibly a boundary map on the back cover. Reg Adair [County councillor] had been approached to help with funding for the delivery of the booklets but had declined, although he had generously offered to actually deliver some himself.

The question set for the coming week was agreed as "Would you like to see a focal point on the Green? If so, what?"

There were only 5 responses to the previous question "Do you know what is meant by the Conservation Area and where this is in Ruddington?" Two knew that there was a map on the PC website and the three others did not really know.

There will be no visitors invited to the next meeting so that the condensation of the Questionnaire can be completed.
