E Gadsby is arranging a meeting with the contact at Notts County Football Club to finalise times and arrangements. Cllr Mrs J Reedman has organised an interpreter (a member of the Choir) for the trip.

Ruddington Fish Bar have offered a discount for the mini fish suppers and a further discount if pizza is ordered for one of the meals as well

Ruddington Colts have confirmed that they will pay 50% of the costs of the mini fish suppers as they will be for all members taking part in the tournament not just the Grenay visitors.

It is estimated that the Twinning Sub-Committees contribution to the Mini Fish Supper and the pizzas would be approximately £305. Cllr P Reedman is to contact the Turkish restaurant to see how much a meal is likely to cost.

Cllr P Reedman had not heard from Anthony Woods, the Co-op Member Pioneer, who had promised to investigate whether Co-op would provide some assistance towards breakfasts for the visitors, he was hoping to see him this week.

A report was being considered at the Environment & Policy Committee meeting at 7.30pm, it was requesting that the budget from Tourism was transferred into Twinning and whether a contribution up to a maximum of £200.00 would be allowed to the Choir for their twinning activity.
