The Gadsbys were travelling to Grenay for the Remembrance Service which was being held on 11th November 2018. There was to be a big ceremony due to the Centenary of World War One. It was believed that the area president was to attend.

Ballyshannon, Ireland & Glauchau, Germany – were going to take part in a football tournament in Grenay in May or June 2019 and asked whether Ruddington would be sending a team. Cllr P Reedman was to ask Sebastien in Grenay for more details and would contact the Ruddington Colts. He would also ask if Grenay were intending to visit on their way back from Ballyshannon, Ireland in August 2019.

Cllr J Reedman had never visited Grenay before and was impressed with how friendly the small community was, it was an old mining community so unemployment was at 20% but they did have a new community building and a lovely concert hall. Prior to the concert a brief tour was given visiting the ancient tree, the red telephone box donated by Ruddington, the murals painted by local children and the War Grave Cemeteries, which was a sombre sight. The Ruddington Tour of Britain sign was presented to Grenay as a gift from the Twinning Committee. Cllr J Reedman was to write an article for The Rudd concerning the visit.

TW. 18/11/06 Grenay Remembrance Visit

E Gadsby & Mrs Gadsby attended Grenay for Remembrance along with P Tarlton-Weatherall and Mrs A Tarlton-Weatherall. As well as the visitors from Ruddington there were visitors from one of Grenay's other twin towns – Glachau in Germany. On Sunday wreaths were laid at the World War Two Resistance Fighters Memorial, the British Memorial and the town's own War Memorial by the representatives from Ruddington.

Grenay representatives arrived in Ruddington and attended the Remembrance Service on Sunday, flowers were laid at the War Memorial during the service by the Grenay representatives.


TW. 18/11/08 August 2019
