A. 17/02/07 St Peter's Rooms and Village Hall Usage

St Peter's Rooms and the Village Hall continue to be popular venues in the village. St Peter's Rooms offering wedding teas, wedding receptions, birthday celebrations and socials. Craft Fairs, charity fundraisers and coffee mornings are particularly popular as hirers can use both the lounge area and the main hall. The Village Hall remains popular for dance classes and children's parties.

Notts County Football Club is now under new ownership and is owned by local businessman Alan Hardy.
