TW. 18/03/06 Twinning Activity - Choir

In 2015 32 members of the Community Choir in Ruddington visited Grenay as part of a twinning activity. A reciprocal visit took place in 2017. This year it is planned to visit again. So far 42 people have indicated that they wish to visit. Grenay has offered to pay to pay for the 1st night at the hotel for everyone. The coach is the biggest expense at £2,900.00. Nottingham Forest had responded that they could not offer a tour, they had been asked for a souvenir instead but no reply had been forthcoming as of yet.

Nottinghamshire County Cricket Club had promised free tickets for the visitors, Cllr P Reedman to confirm numbers closer to the time.

Letter had been sent to Notts County Football Club requesting a tour of their stadium, response expected shortly.

Resolved that: Clerk to check whether the Parish Council had the appropriate licence to show films. Cllr J Reedman to contact tourist information to ask whether there were any free events scheduled for 10th/11th/12th May. Peter McGowan was to check if there were any steam trains running on the evening of 12th May as he may be able to get complimentary tickets. Clerk to check whether the classroom at the Country Park was available to hire and whether the watching of films is permitted.
