Resolved that: The observations contained in Planning Schedule 829 are adopted.

A. 19/02/08 Clifton Road Allotment Security

A lengthy discussion took place regarding the issues raised and the solutions suggested by the residents, along with suggestions by Parish Councillors

Resolved that: a 4ft metal fence should be installed approximately 1.2m from the boundary fence of the residents (the footpath tapers at the far end and would prevent use of the footpath by the resident of the furthest property if it follows the boundary of the footpath).

A. 19/02/09 Elms Park Kitchen

The kitchen is extremely small and the Cricket Club would like to extend it to accommodate a refrigerator

Resolved that: an extension to the kitchen is approved, the Parish Council to take the opportunity to install a fire rated door and shutter as part of the work.

A. 19/02/10 Lighting, Church Street Car Park

The Church Street car park currently has only one standard lamp post and the Parish Council has received complaints that it is not sufficient to light the whole car park.

Resolved that: A feasibility study will be conducted to investigate the installation of additional/improved lighting. Costs and implications to be bought to a future meeting.

A request to fund a petanque pitch within the White Horse car park had been received, this could be positioned over 5 of the parking bays, which would still be available for parking during the day.



Resolved that: The Parish Council would fund the creation of an area to play petanque within the car park of the White Horse, this would cost approximately £960.00 and be funded from the Amenities R&R budget
