#### ES.19/06/07 Hire of Ruddy Duck

Discussions were held around whether it would be appropriate to hire out Ruddy Duck. It was decided that it would be better if the Events Sub-Committee remain in control of appearances by Ruddy Duck.

Guidelines should be drawn up about how long the costume should be worn and experience would be gathered after Ruddy Duck's inaugural appearance at the Summer Fayre in July.

If Ruddy Duck is required at other events a contribution towards the Parish council nominated charity will be requested.

A deputy wearer for the Ruddy Duck costume had been found.

A DBS check has been investigated and will not be required for the wearer of the costume.

Another visit for Ruddy Duck has been arranged for the visit of French children from Grenay in August.

**Resolved that:** Guidelines should be drawn up about the length of time the Ruddy Duck costume can be worn.
