ES. 19/08/04A Ruddington Village Centre Partnership – Christmas 2020

The Christmas Fayre has been run for the last six year by the Events Sub-Committee. A report is being prepared for the next Parish Council on 24th September detailing a proposal by the Ruddington Village Centre Partnership (RVCP) to take over the running of the Christmas Fayre in December 2020.

The Events Sub-Committee have been asked for their views so that these can be incorporated into the report going to Parish Council. Members of the Events Sub-Committee expressed disappointment at the lack of consultation before the proposal was brought to the Parish Council. However the plan and ideas set out in the proposal were received positively.

The Events Sub-Committee suggested that a number of stipulations should be added to the Christmas 2020 proposal and that the Parish Council would ensure that these were met.
