Resolved that: Youth Services can use the Village Hall free of charge to provide a service for young people within the village.


C. 22/12/13 Community Speed Watch Scheme

- b) Poppy appeal box placed at St Peter's Rooms raised £31.77
- c) Cllr Pell attended Conservation Area Appraisal meeting on 28th November 2022. Window competition awards were presented, 1st Placed was Zing Interiors, 2nd Placed was Perkins Hardware, 3rd Placed was Tomlinson Estates. Highly Commended was awarded to Reggie who produced the window art at Mortons & The White Horse. Cllr Hawson attended a Hareham Gardens meeting on 27th November 2022
- d) Community Centre Working Party – Bats had been found within the building so the demolition was to be delayed and will probably take place in May 2023. The business plan is expected to be completed by February 2023.
- e) RVCP – Christmas market was very successful, feedback mainly positive. All feedback will be considered as part of the planning for future years. Shops and traders reported it as their most successful day of the year. Only 20 volunteers managed the whole event. The Parish Council was very grateful that RVCP had organised the event and wanted their thanks passing onto them.
